

# Rambles around the IW

## in association with the IW Ramblers



**Description:** A short walk from the village passing Appuldurcombe House.

**Distance:** 2.5 miles

**Start:** At the Four Seasons pub - a walker friendly pub - car park can be used with permission - or park in the road. Also Station Road car park.

**Access Information:** Fairly level walk with 2 stiles.

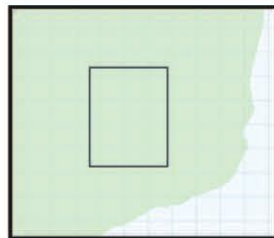
**Refreshments:** Pubs in Wroxall.

**Toilets:** No public toilets at Wroxall.

**Route:** From the Four Seasons pub (1), go to the road junction and continue along the road downhill. At the Spar shop, turn left into West Street (2). The road narrows as it leaves the village. At a left bend, turn right onto footpath GL47, a rough track (3). At a 5 bar gate, take the right hand gate and continue on a grassy path to a metal bridlegate. Worsley Monument can be seen on the left. Keep on

the footpath as it passes to the front of Appuldurcombe House, and then cross a stile at the lane (4).

Continue straight on with a car park on the right. Continue along the track with farm buildings on the left, and at a bend, continue on through a gateway. As the path approaches Freemantle gate, turn sharp right onto GL44 (5). At a 5 bar gate, cross a stile and go left on the lane (6). Pass stone pillars and continue straight on along Appuldurcombe Road, ignoring a road to the left. Turn right at Avenue Road (7). Where the road goes left, continue on through a staggered gate, and then between houses along Coombe Park. Follow this road as it goes left to a T-junction (8). Turn right along the main road passing a church and the Worsley Arms pub, returning to start point.
